Programming Instructions



Before proceeding, please ensure your unit was installed by a qualified dealer or according to our **installation instructions**.

Congratulations on your purchase of **The Cart Key**[®] electronic security device for your golf cart or ATV. Please read these instructions carefully before proceeding to program your device's User IDs.

Programming The Cart Key

The Cart Key[®] is preprogrammed with the default **Factory Code** 1 2 3 4. To start your cart for the first time:

- Turn the ignition switch and wait for the red light on The Cart Key[®] to light up.
- 2. Enter the **Factory Code 1 2 3 4**. The green light will flash and then stay on.
- 3. Proceed to **Programming a Primary User ID**

You must immediately change the Factory Code to ensure your vehicle's security. When you change the Factory Code you will be programming your own customized **Primary User ID**.


Failure to change from the default Factory Code will void your warranty.

D Understanding User IDs

The **Primary User ID** has complete control of The Cart Key[®] and is the only user that can add, change or delete additional **User IDs**.

Once a Primary User ID is programmed (replacing the **Factory Code**) it is the only ID that can operate your cart. After you program your **Primary User ID**, you should immediately set up at least one additional User ID. If the **Primary User ID** is lost or deleted, then The Cart Key[®] can not be reprogrammed. If you lose the **Primary User ID** and no additional **User IDs** exist, then your vehicle will be inoperable!

All IDs should be immediately recorded after they are programmed.

Programming a Primary User ID

- 1. Turn the ignition switch on and wait for the red light on The Cart Key[®] to light up.
- If this is your first time programming, enter the Factory Code 1 2 3 4. If you have already programmed a Primary User ID, enter it instead. The green light flashes and then stays on.
- 3. Press and hold the 0/1 key and immediately release it when the green light starts flashing.
- 4. Enter a new private four digit **Primary User ID**. The red light will flash each time a key is pressed. After 4 keys are pressed, the green light will flash and your new **Primary User ID** is now set. The old Primary User ID or Factory Code has been replaced and your new **Primary User ID** is the only code that will control The Cart Key[®].
- 5. Document the new **Primary User ID** in multiple locations. Proceed to programming at least one additional user ID, if none already exist.

DO NOT assign any combination of the 0/1 key) as your Primary User ID.


For example, you must avoid $0 0 0 0$,	
1 1 1 1, 1 0 1 0, 1 0 0 0, etc.]	•

This code sequence is reserved for disabling User IDs. Using any combination of the 0/1 key as your **Primary User ID** will disable The Cart Key[®] and your warranty will be voided.

Programming Additional User IDs

You can add up to 4 additional access codes by programming **User IDs**. Only your **Primary User ID** can be used to add, change or delete additional users.

The 5 keys on The Cart Key[®] represent the 5 IDs that can be programmed. The 0/1 key is for the **Primary User ID**, and the keys 2/3, 4/5, 6/7 and 8/9 represent the 4 additional **User IDs** that can be programmed in.



Adding User IDs

- Turn on the ignition switch and wait for the red light on The Cart Key[®] to light up.
- 2. Enter your **Primary User ID**. The green light will flash, then stop.
- To add User ID #1, press and hold the (2/3 key) and immediately release it when the green light starts flashing (about 2 seconds).
- 4. When the green light stops flashing, enter the desired 4 digit **User ID**. The red light will flash each time a key is pressed, and the green light will flash after the 4th key is pressed, signaling the User ID is set.
- Turn off the ignition switch and then turn it back on. Enter the new User ID to ensure it is operational.
- 6. Ensure each User ID button & corresponding code is recorded.

Additional users can now operate the cart by turning on the ignition switch and entering the 4 digit **User ID** you have programmed for them.

Changing User IDs

You can change a **User ID** by following the **Adding User IDs** procedure. In step #3, press and hold the corresponding key for the User ID you wish to change and proceed to step 4. You do not have to delete a User ID to change it.

Remember to document all new User IDs.

Deleting User IDs

You can delete a User ID by following **Adding User IDs** procedure, and again in step #3 press and hold the corresponding key for the User ID you wish to delete.

In step #4 enter the delete code of $\bigcirc \bigcirc \bigcirc \bigcirc \bigcirc$. This will delete that User ID. Once a User ID is deleted it can be reprogrammed in with a new or a previously used User ID.

A Remember: DO NOT delete your **Primary User ID**!

General Operation

- 1. Turn the ignition switch on and wait until the red light on The Cart Key[®] lights up.
- 2. Enter the 4 digit code for your desired User ID. The green light will flash and then stay on.
- 3. You're ready to go!
